

Puppy Sale Agreement

This contract is between Edwards Training and _____.

The following puppy _____ was born on _____ is hereby sold to the undersigned total purchased price of _____, which must be paid in full before the puppy is released to the new owner. The seller, by accepting a deposit/full payment of _____ (for each puppy requested) agrees to hold the puppy for the buyer until release time. The deposit is **non-refundable** deposit that will be subtracted from the total price.

The following puppy _____, to the best of the sellers knowledge is in good health and free of communicable diseases at time of sale. The puppy will have at least two sets of vaccines, bordatella vaccine and wormed before released to new owner. Validation of the guarantee requires examination of your new puppy by the veterinarian of your choice and at the purchaser's expense within 48 hours after taking/delivery of the puppy. Retain your receipt of the checkup this is mandatory to have the guarantee. If this is not done, the health guarantee becomes invalid and buyer assumes all responsibility for health of the puppy. The guarantee against transmissible diseases such as the parvo virus is valid for a period of 7 days, starting on the day of delivery, since the normal incubation period for transmissible diseases is 5-7 days. The breeder guarantees the puppy until 1 year of age against all life threatening congenital or hereditary defects. If the puppy has a life threatening congenital or hereditary defect, it will be replaced with the first available puppy of the same value from the breeders stock, as soon as possible. The original puppy must be returned (at owners expense), to breeder before a new puppy can be delivered. The purchaser is responsible for any shipping fees for the replacement puppy. In the event of a death, a licensed veterinarian must perform an autopsy to determine the exact cause of death at owner's expense. The report from the autopsy must be sent to my attending veterinarian to review. The health guarantee does **NOT** include hernias/ruptures, hypoglycemia, coccidiosis, giardia (which can be caused by stress of going to a new home), ear mites, worms, fleas/ticks or any other treatable issues. All veterinarian charges, incurred by the purchaser, are the sole responsibility of the purchaser and will under no circumstances be paid by the seller. All puppies are sold as pets, as no guarantee is made as to disposition, conformation, size, weight, color, or breeding ability. Puppies are sold strictly as pets. All guarantees shall become null and void if the puppy is sold, gave away, or transferred to another person.

This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement, promises, or inducement made by either party that is not contained in the written contract shall be valid or binding. This contract may not be modified or altered except in writing signed by both parties and endorsed herein. By purchasing your puppy you the buyer agree that you have read, understand and accept the terms of the contract.
